



Extended Day, Before & After School and Full Day Child Care Programs within Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board

Extended Day Program for Full Day Kindergarten Students:

Compliant with the operational framework of Education Act under s.259, Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board will be providing, on a fee basis, through third party providers, extended day programs for full day kindergarten students at the following school locations:

- Apsley Public School – Kawartha Child Care Services, effective September 7, 2010
- Brighton Public School – Brighton District Family Resource Centre, effective September 6, 2011
- Central (Bowmanville) Public School – YMCA GTA, effective September 6, 2011
- Charles Bowman Public School – Kawartha Child Care Services, effective September 6, 2011
- Ganaraska Trail Public School – Ganaraska Child Care Centre, effective September 7, 2010
- Otonabee Valley Public School – Nursery Two Child Care, effective September 6, 2011
- Prince of Wales Public School – Kawartha Child Care Services, effective September 7, 2010

The following full day kindergarten school sites were surveyed for interest in extended day programs, but did not generate sufficient numbers to be deemed viable:

- Colborne Public School
- Hastings Public School
- Grant Sine Public School
- Orono Public School
- Roseneath Public School

Keith Wightman Public School will be supported with extended day program services by Nursery Two Child Care, located at the adjacent school, St. Alphonus Elementary School.

Kawartha Pine Ridge District School is required to determine its own base fees if an extended day program was offered directly by the school board. By establishing these fees in advance, KPRDSB confirms that should a third party provider cease operations, and where a program is deemed viable, the board would provide the extended day program directly, on a timely basis, based on the following base fees:

For 2011/2012 school year:

Before School (from 7:00 am – Morning Bell time)	\$12.00/day
After School (from End of Day Bell – 6 pm)	\$13.00/day
For both Before School & After School	\$25.00/day
For full day (7:00 am – 6:00 pm, non-instructional day)	\$49.00/day

NOTE: Northumberland Hills Public School is currently being reviewed for extended day and before & after child care programs. At this time, the survey results are not deemed viable, however KPRDSB continues to seek a third party provider for this school site. Should a program be established at this location, further information would be circulated through www.kprschools.ca.
