IMPORTANT UPDATE for Students and Families Assigned to Campeau Bus Lines Routes

This note provides an important update on contract negotiations between Campeau Bus Lines Ltd. and Unifor, the union representing the company's school bus drivers.

We have learned that the union has attained a strike vote; however, we remain hopeful for a positive outcome. Unifor has said it will give families 72 hours' notice if a strike is imminent and we will provide timely updates so that affected families can plan accordingly.

Busing is continuing until further notice is provided. Please continue to follow us daily for the latest updates.

This note provides an important update on contract negotiations between Campeau Bus Lines Ltd. and Unifor, the union representing the company's school bus drivers.

We have learned that negotiations are continuing and that the union did not hold a strike vote Thursday evening. Given Unifor's assurance that it will give families 72 hours' notice if a strike is imminent, this means that **Campeau busing will continue as usual this Monday, February 11.**

We will follow the situation closely, and we remain hopeful for a positive outcome. IMPORTANT NOTICE for Students and Families Assigned to Campeau Bus Lines Routes

This note provides an important update on contract negotiations between Campeau Bus Lines Ltd. and Unifor, the union representing the company's school bus drivers.

As part of the negotiations process, Unifor has advised the company that they may be holding a strike vote meeting on Thursday, February 7. Unifor also stated that, in the event of job action, the union is committed to giving parents and the public 72 hours' notice. Therefore, if a strike vote is taken and if the drivers vote to strike, the earliest possible service disruption would be Monday, February 11.

Student Transportation Services of Central Ontario (STSCO), therefore, encourages families of students who ride Campeau buses to:

- check the stsco.ca website often, and stay tuned to local news media, for any possible updates
- consider having alternative plans for getting their children to school in case of a possible strike
