Each KPR school is invited to apply for funding (up to \$300/Elementary and \$500/Secondary School) to create an initiative that addresses equity topics in your school. Funds can be used to support awareness raising campaigns on equity issues, such as:

- Ableism
- Gender Identity
- Islamophobia
- Racism
- Classism
- Indigenous Education
- LGBTQ+ Discrimination
- Sexism, etc...

All proposals should be submitted to the Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Department by Wednesday, December 13th at 4:00pm.

Who should apply?

Some schools have existing groups that focus on equity topics (Ex. social justice group, GSA, Open Doors club, Harmony Group, etc.). These groups may have a project they want funded. Schools can also create a new group.

Can we apply as a class?

This funding is intended to spark or enhance student led projects outside of the classroom and is specifically for student groups. If you are looking for equity classroom based activities or lesson plans, KPR has a variety of materials and speakers that can be accessed through the Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Department.

When will we know if our group will receive funding?

All groups will be notified via email by Friday, December 22nd, and all funds should be spent during the 2017/2018 school year.

Are there any supports or resources for supervising staff?

Students and staff will be able to access the Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Advisor for specific support and resources. All participating staff will be connected through an Edsby group in order to share additional resources, ideas and questions.

What is required of the group for reporting?

Groups will be required to submit a short summary of their projects, how the money was spent and what the impact was. We also encourage schools to share pictures and project updates through Edsby, Twitter (@kprschools) or email.
