Board Report

Trustee A. Lloyd updated the committee on events and initiatives being undertaken by the Board. The Board is moving forward with the development of the Intermediate school at Crestwood. A Transition Committee is being established with students, parents and staff to assist in making the transition as smooth as possible. The Director's Annual Report was reviewed, and the school calendar was approved. Everyone will be busy in the upcoming month and everyone is saddened with the tragic loss of Trustee S. Patterson.

Presentation:

Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD)

Kim Carson, Co-ordinator, Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder Peterborough, provided the Committee with the definition of FASD and her role as it pertains to the community and the students in our schools. FASD Peterborough is changing the definition to remove the blame and stigma of FASD. David Beardmore, Behaviour Support Assistant (BSA), KPRDSB, informed the Committee how the BSAs are using appropriate intervention strategies to build self-worth and resilience in our students.

Their presentations will be distributed to the Committee for review. L. Schoenmaker informed the Committee that K. Carson and D. Beardmore have presented to KPRDSB support staff to provide more information regarding FASD in our schools. One of the challenges faced is the current mindset of FASD held by teachers and support staff.

D. Beardmore provided a hand-out which demonstrated the overlapping behavioural characteristics and related mental health diagnoses in children. He also explained to the Committee what techniques are modelled and how these techniques are implemented with support staff to build self-worth and resilience in students.

Special Education Policy Review

Superintendent A.M. Duncan explained why the Strategic Priorities were not being discussed tonight, deferring to March meeting. The Special Education Leadership team has been reviewing all Special Education policies and administrative regulations. SEAC is an important part of the feedback process for the policy. A.M. Duncan informed SEAC of policy review process.

The Special Education Leadership Team saw this review as an opportunity to enshrine more of our values into policy.

Superintendent A.M. Duncan reviewed and explained the draft policy with members of the Committee and received feedback.

This Policy will be going to March Program Review Committee for approval after feedback is incorporated from SEAC.

Administrative Update

The Special Education Department, specifically the Instructional Leadership Consultants and System Principals – Special Education have been part of the Intensive Math Support School program. We have 11 schools involved in the program. These schools are chosen based on their EQAO scores and demographics at their schools. Schools that require extra math coaches, receive a half day math coach and access to extra Professional Development Days.

Superintendent A.M. Duncan is a member of the Workplace Violence Subcommittee of the Occupational Health and Safety Committee. The unions (ETFO, CUPE, OSSTF) work with management on pro-active strategies to be put in place to prevent workplace violence. Currently, the group reviews reports and how we are supporting our employees to keep them safe.

The Special Education central staff are providing training for Special Education Support Staff and Designated Early Childhood Educators (DECE) on strike days. Topics include: Safe Talk, trauma in our schools, executive functioning, managing anxiety, FASD, SEA training, self-regulation, personal well-being, and promoting positive behaviour. The sessions are very practical and have been very well received. Should job action continue, support staff will have worked through all topics.
