The Summer School Dual Credit Program is for you!

KPR is pleased to partner with Fleming College to offer an *Intro to Carpentry course*. This dual credit course is for students in grades 11 or 12. The course is 45hrs of instructional time on campus at Fleming Sutherland Campus in Peterborough. Students successful in the course earn both a high school credit, and a Fleming College Carpentry Program credit. What are Dual Credits?

Dual Credit courses are college courses delivered by the college faculty to secondary school students. If successful, students will get both secondary school and college credit(s). There are no costs associated with Dual Credit courses for secondary school students. Dual Credit courses are designed to assist students in making a seamless transition from secondary school to college or to an apprenticeship. One of the greatest advantages of taking a Dual Credit course is having college experience.
