Regulation: STUDENT REGISTRATION/
ADMISSION – LEGAL GUARDIANSHIP

Policy Code Reference: ES-5.1
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This administrative regulation is written in accordance with the guiding principles in Board Policy No. ES-5.1, Student Registration/Admission.

1. The Education Act defines a guardian as a person who has lawful custody of a child, other than the parent of a child. Therefore, the non-parent of a student of compulsory school age, may register a student, once the following condition has been met.
2. A copy of a true or notarized document establishing guardianship must be received by the school principal and filed within the student's Ontario School Record folder at the time of registration. For the purpose of this regulation, documented evidence to exhibit legal guardianship will include one of the following:
 - 2.1 a permanent or interim court order,
 - 2.2 a Consent/Authorization and Direction form (Appendix A),
 - 2.3 a will, or
 - 2.4 a document establishing wardship with the Children's Aid Society.
